## TROOP CARRIER GROUP ASSOCIATION

A Pictorial Report of the 1984 Reunion  
at San Francisco, California October 4, 5, 6

The WWII 315th Troop Carrier Group Association's 1984 reunion held in San Francisco at the Marines' Memorial on October 4, 5, and 6 was a great success. Our host committee, headed by Bob Cloer did a superb job of planning the event, and without a doubt, everyone attending had a wonderful time. Even the weather cooperated because the time we had in the "City by the Bay" was marked by sunny, comfortable weather.

Planned activities at the 1984 reunion were similar to previous reunions in that we had a cocktail party on Thursday and Friday and on Saturday before the banquet which marked the finale of the reunion. A board meeting, attended by officers and directors of the Association was held on the afternoon of October 4 and a business meeting took place on Saturday morning, Oct. 6.

Two daytime and one evening excursion planned by Lloyd and Rita Perry were very popular with all who went on them. The "California Sampler" tour, in particular, was a big hit with those fortunate enough to have signed up for it.

#### OFFICERS AND DIRECTORS MEETING

The meeting, attended by officers and directors of the Association, was convened at 14:30 hours by President Carl Fittkau. Present were Krysakowski, Papp, Cloer, Lemberg, Dean, Lyon, Reading, Alexander, Drummey, Liddle, Coggins, McRae and Sternoff.

The first item of business was a proposed amendment to Article IX of the Articles of Association which stipulates preparation of a budget to enable the Treasurer to pay bills without seeking approval from officers and directors. Also, it would allow the President to authorize emergency expenditures not exceeding \$500. The directors approved the Amendment by unanimous vote.

A proposal to grant honorary membership in the Association to five of our friends in Holland and Britain was introduced and enthusiastically endorsed. The candidates are Father Gerard Thuring, Jan Bos and Mrs. W. W. "Tonny" Winkler-Koet in Holland and Dave Benfield and Captain James S. C. Flavell in England. Final approval will be solicited at the business meeting on Saturday.

Next, some general subjects regarding mailings to people on our roster and membership dues were discussed and instructions given to the editor of the NEWSLETTER to include the subjects in the next issue to be published.

The Nominating Committee presented its report. The report was accepted and will be presented to the membership at the business meeting on Saturday.

Joe Krysakowski gave a report on the progress he is making on getting tax-free status for the

315th Association from the IRS. He reported slow, but steady progress and expressed the hope that he will finish the job in 1985.

Duncan McRae provided information to the group about the 8th Air Force Museum being built in the Shreveport area. The 315th TCG will be represented in it by a C-47 aircraft. (Duncan didn't mention it, but he was largely responsible for obtaining the aircraft and paying to have it flown from Arizona to Shreveport.)

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned at approximately 16:15 hours.

#### SATURDAY MORNING BUSINESS MEETING

President Fittkau called the meeting to order at 09:15 and introduced the subject of honorary memberships for our Dutch and English friends. Bob Cloer gave the members brief descriptions of each individuals' connections with, or contribution to the 315th Association. Coggins moved that the five people be made Honorary Members. His motion was seconded and passed unanimously.

President Fittkau then announced the next items of business were (a) the Treasurer's report, (b) minutes of the last business meeting, (c) presentation of the Nominating Committee's report and (d) selection of the site for the 1986 reunion. He emphasized the point that the Articles of Association which govern us provide for the membership to direct the actions of the Association. In this connection he said nominations for officers and directors would be welcomed from the floor. He then read that portion of the Articles of Association dealing with the function of a Nominating Committee.

Marty Dean gave a short Treasurer's report, the substance of which was that the Association's bills were paid to date and that we had \$2049. in the bank. He said a detailed report would be given to anyone requesting same after the meeting. The President asked the members if they wished to hear the minutes of the 1982 business meeting read. The membership replied in the negative.

Col. Lyon then made the Nominating Committee's report. The recommended slate was as follows:

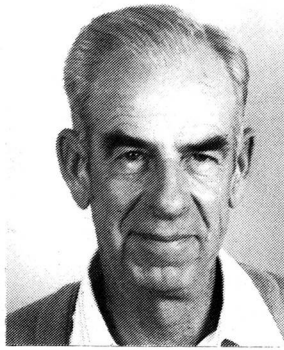
The President opened the nominations for directors and officers from the floor. There being none, a motion was made and seconded to accept the Nominating Committee's report. Motion was passed unanimously.

President Fittkau asked incoming President Joe Krysakowski to lead the discussion of a site for the 1986 reunion. Joe reviewed the requirements for a reunion location and asked for suggestions from the floor. Though a number of sites (San Antonio, Orlando, Charleston, Portland ME, Dayton, Chicago) were mentioned, only Jake Sternoff was prepared to make a presentation for Seattle, WA. Following a general discussion of sites, Coggins moved that we meet in Seattle in 1986. A vote was taken on Coggins' motion and it passed unanimously. SO SEATTLE IT IS IN 1986!!!!

Under new business, one of the members expressed the thought that we should have a distinctive 315th Association cap to wear at reunions. Another suggested that we copy the Confederate Air Force caps so we could all be Colonels! President Fittkau requested that any information developed about such a cap be sent to Ed Papp for inclusion in the NEWSLETTER. Coggins brought up the subject of Bill Brinson's history of the 315th Troop Carrier Group and said it would be on sale immediately after the business meeting was over.

In closing, President Fittkau thanked the officers and directors and the entire membership for the help he had received during his term in office. He was given a standing ovation by the entire group.

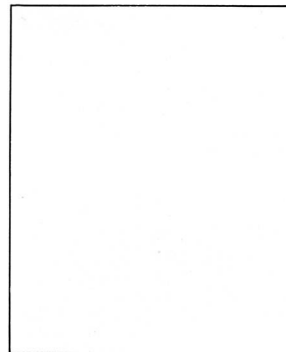

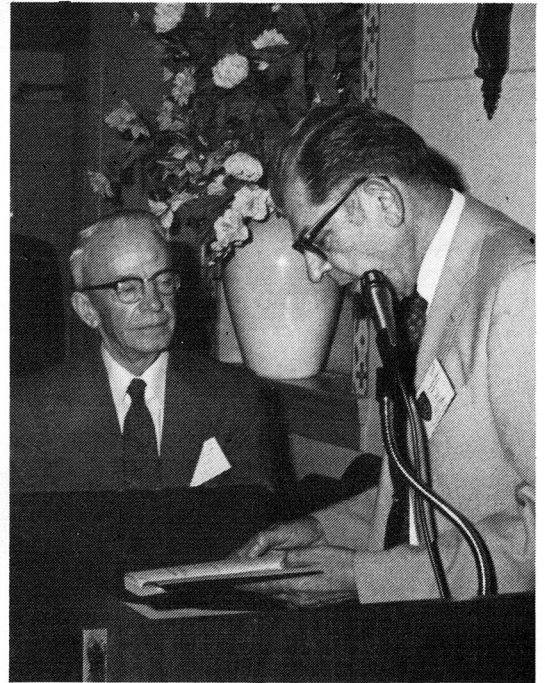

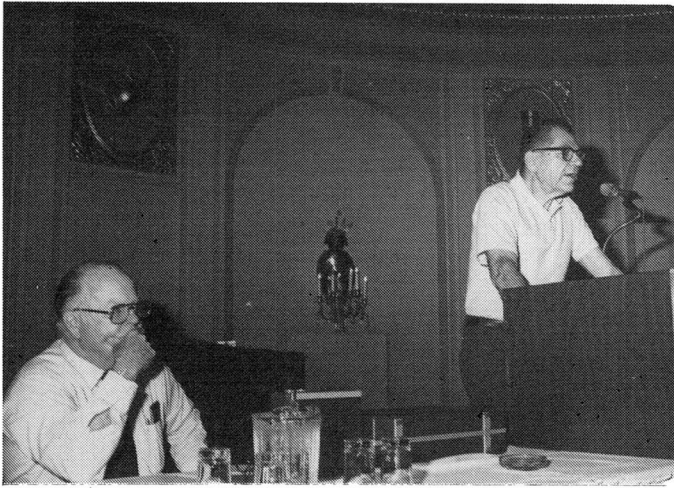

Despite the early hour, more than a hundred men attended the meeting.



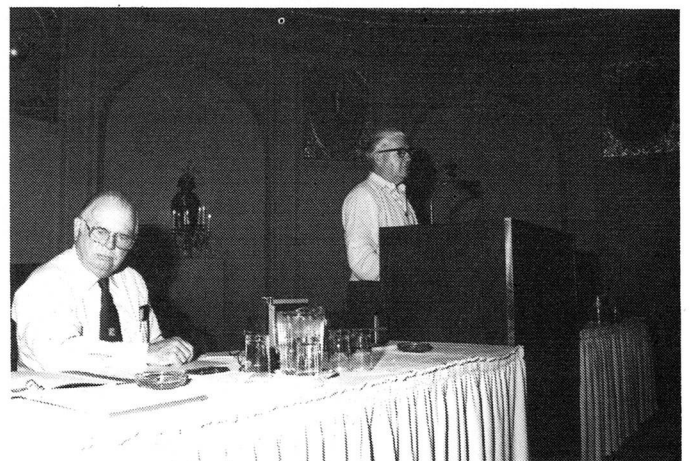

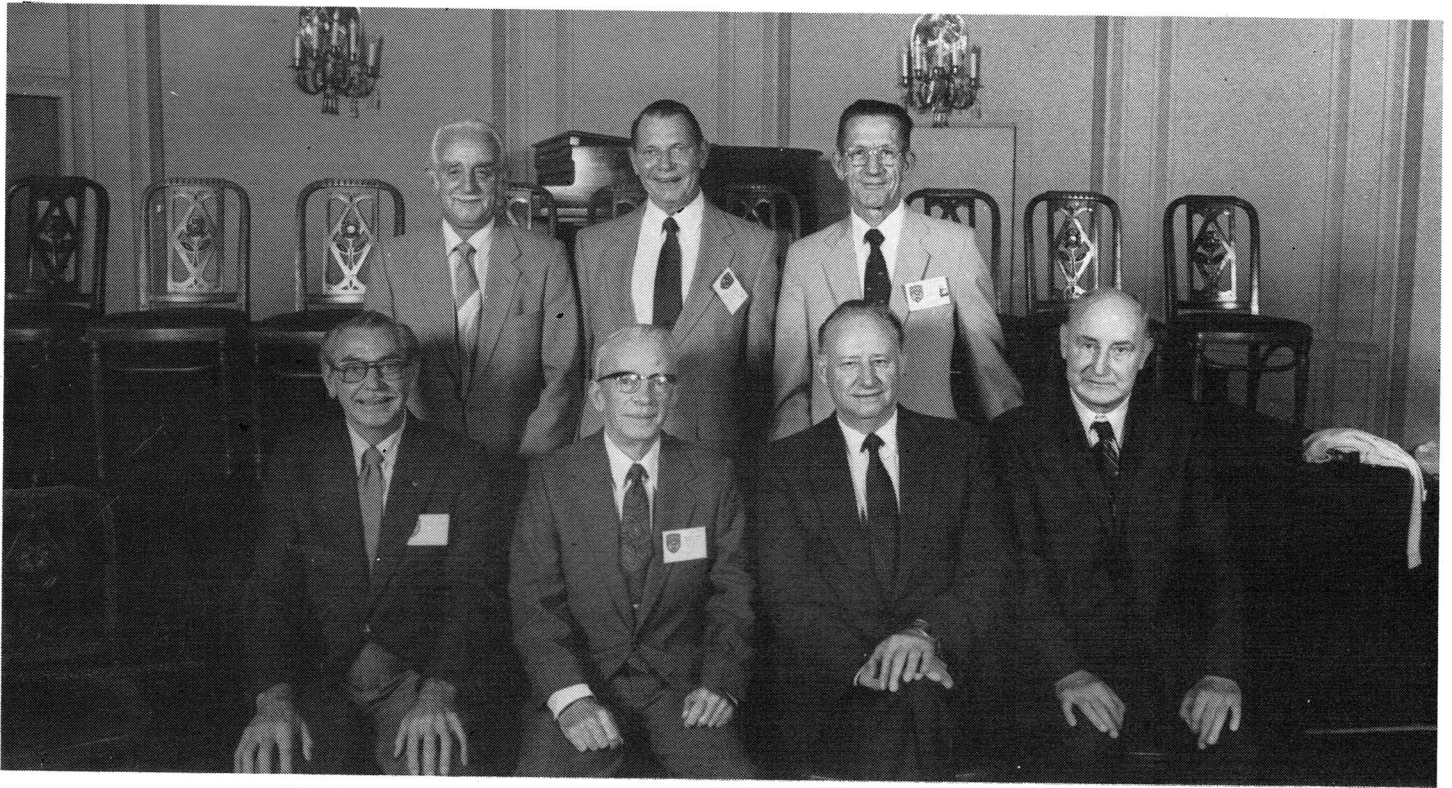
Careful attention to everything that went on during the meeting is evident from the expressions seen in this picture.

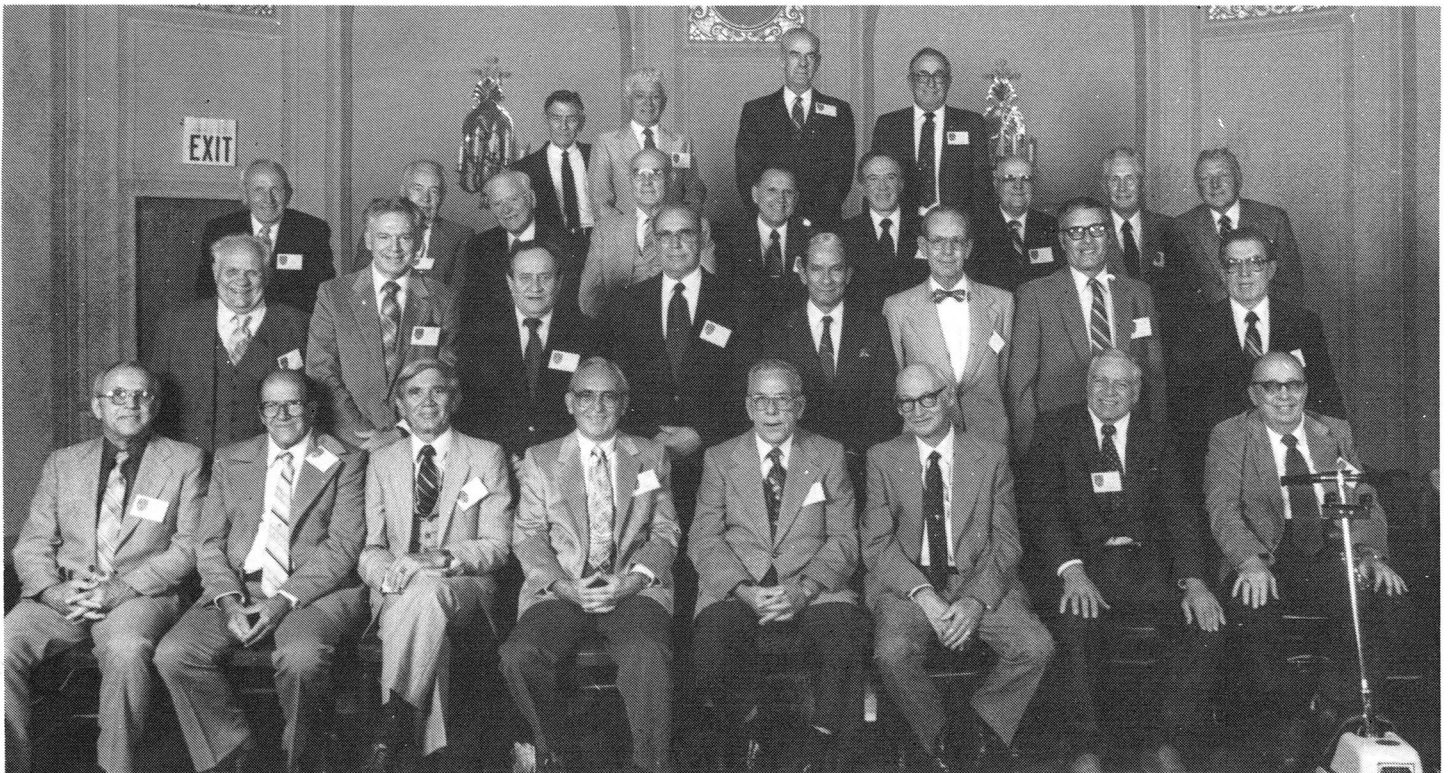

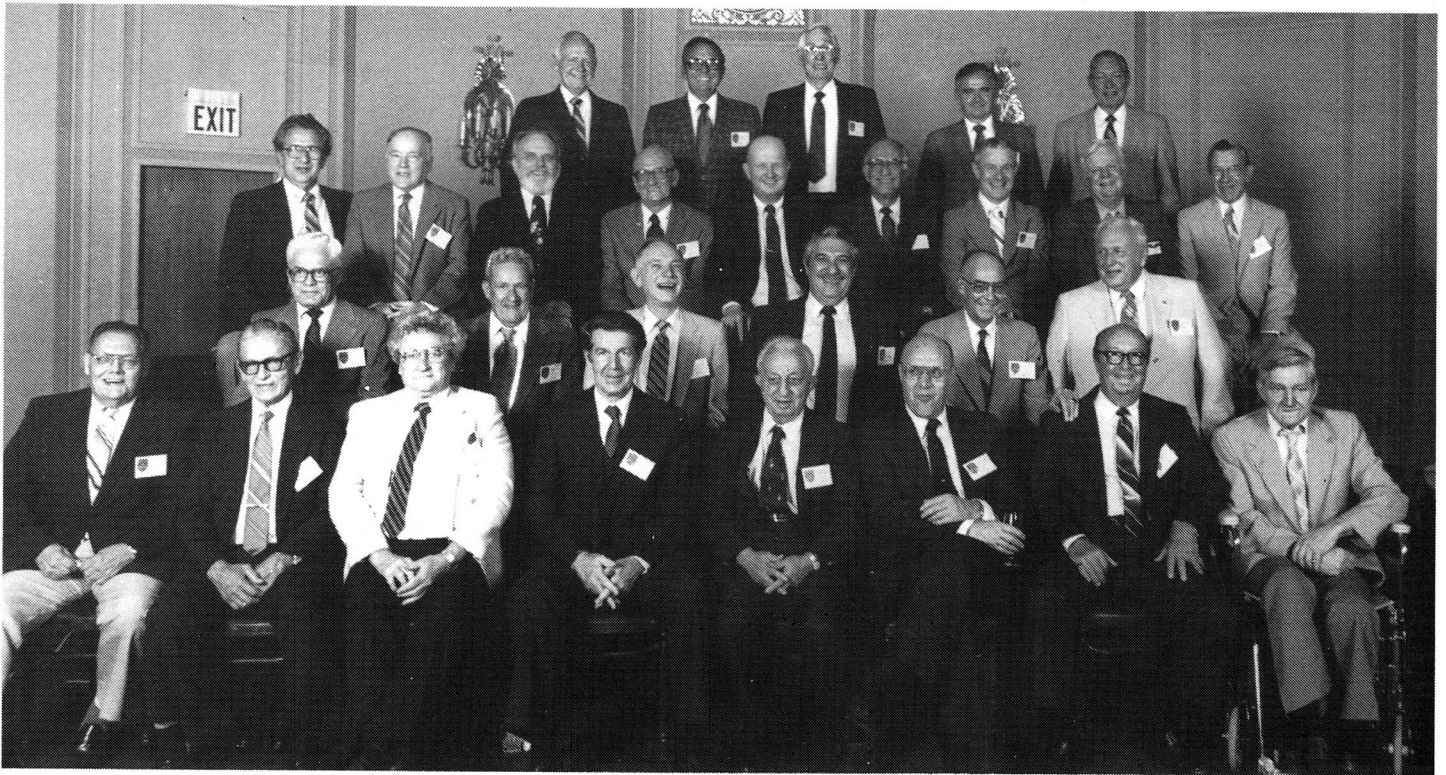
